POLICY: 706

PAYROLL DEDUCTIONS

Ease of administration shall be the primary consideration for payroll deductions, other than those required

by law. Payroll deductions are made for federal income tax withholdings, lowa income tax withholdings federal

insurance contributions, and the Iowa Public Employees' Retirement System (IPERS).

The district may deduct wages as required or allowed by state or federal law or by order of a court of

competent jurisdiction. Employees may elect to have payments withheld from their pay for items authorized by

law, subject to agreement of the district. Requests for these deductions shall be made in writing to the

Superintendent.

It shall be the responsibility of the Superintendent or Superintendent's designee to determine which

additional payroll deductions will be allowed.
