POLICY: 710

SCHOOL MEALS PROGRAM

The District shall operate, or provide for the operation of, a school meals program. The District will

participate in the National School Lunch Program and School Breakfast program and accepts the responsibility for

providing free or reduced-price meals to eligible children. Free or reduced-price meals shall be provided to those

students whose parents/guardians are unable to pay for the cost of the meals according to the guidelines of the

Federal Lunch Program. The guidelines for reduced-priced meals are a part of the National School Lunch Act of

1946 and the Child Nutrition Act of 1966. The purpose of the program shall be to provide nutritionally adequate

meals to students on a non-profit basis. Students may bring their lunch from home and purchase milk, juice or

other incidental items. The School Food Program is an enterprise fund and is subject to the rules and regulations

of business-type activities according to GASB 34. The revenues of the School Food program will be used only for

paying the regular operating costs of the School Food Program. School District tax funds may be used to provide

necessary physical plant facilities, purchase the initial equipment of Food Service in new or existing buildings, and

replace major items of equipment. Prices for meals shall be annually reviewed and established by the Board.
