EMPLOYEE INVOLVEMENT IN THE COMMUNITY

Employees are encouraged to get involved in the community and its activities, including politics.

Employees involved in politics can teach about and model active citizenship, as well as stimulate student interest in politics but shall not advocate a specific partisan political philosophy. When an employee decides to run for a political office, the person shall not use their position in any way to attain election, to promote their political objectives, and the political activity must not interfere with his/her District responsibilities and obligations.
