MEMBERSHIP QUALIFICATIONS

Serving on the board of directors is an honor and privilege. Its rewards are respect from the community, students, and employees and the satisfaction from knowing each board member contributed to the success of the children in the school district community. Only those who are willing to put forth the effort to care and to make a difference should consider running for a position on the board.

Individuals who are willing to serve on the board should believe public education is important, support the democratic process, willingly devote time and energy to board work, respect educators and have the ability to examine the facts and make a decision. The board believes an individual considering a position on the school board should possess these characteristics.

Citizens wanting to run for a position on the board must be a citizen of the school district, an eligible elector of the district and free from a financial conflict of interest with the position.

The Board shall consist of seven members. Each member is elected for a full term at a regularly scheduled school election in November of odd-numbered years, for four years or to complete the unexpired term of a regularly elected member. Each member, to qualify, must be a qualified elector of the District and take the oath of office at a Board meeting.
