

POLICY: 202.6

INDIVIDUAL BOARD MEMBERS

Each Board member has legal authority only when the Board is in legal session, except as authorized by specific Board action or by statute. The Board is not bound in any way by any statement or action on the part of an individual Board member, except when such statement or action is in pursuance of specific instructions given by the Board.

Board members may find themselves together at social affairs. Informal discussion about such matters as educational trends, issues, and innovations and general school district problems are possible. However, all parties are reminded that individual Board members have no authority until they convene at a meeting of the Board. Discussions of specific personnel or personnel grievances shall be considered unethical conduct.
