POLICY: 205.3

BOARD MEMBER DEVELOPMENT

Board member development shall be encouraged. Development occurs when Board members attend Board conferences, workshops, and conventions. The following principles and procedures are to be used:

- a calendar of Board conferences, conventions, and workshops shall be maintained by the Secretary. The Board will decide which meetings appear to be appropriate for producing direct and indirect benefits to the District. The Board will identify the cost/benefits for member participation at meetings.
- funds for participation at meetings will be budgeted on an annual basis. When funds are limited, the Board will designate which of its members would be the most appropriate to attend a given meeting.
- when a conference, convention, or workshop is not attended by all of the Board, those who do attend will share information acquired at the meeting.
