

Policy: 301.7

PROTECTION OF SECURITY INFORMATION

Pursuant to the Code of Iowa a school district is entitled to protect from disclosure certain information which could otherwise meet the definition of a public record which concerns security procedures or emergency preparedness and is developed or maintained by the District if the district deems that disclosure could reasonably be expected to jeopardize the safety of students, employees, visitors, other persons or property.

The following specific records or classes of records are declared to be restricted from public disclosure and are only to be disclosed to those District employees and officials who are directly involved in such protective measures to the extent that each needs to be informed. Decisions about granting access to specific individuals and agencies shall be made by the Superintendent or his/her designee:

1. Security plans and procedures including codes, combinations, passwords, etc.
2. Emergency response protocols.
