STUDENT INVOLVEMENT IN DECISION-MAKING

Student involvement in the decision-making process of the school is encouraged in order to create a stimulating learning climate and develop a spirit of inquiry. To accomplish that, the Board supports: (a) active student participation in the establishment of course goals, in the planning of classroom activities, and in discussions on how to improve courses; (b) student expressions without fear; (c) active student involvement in the planning of assembly programs and school-sponsored forums; (d) active involvement in student government and other organizations that provide students with a voice in school affairs; and (e) active involvement in extra-curricular activities.
