

POLICY: 501.2

ENTRANCE AGE

The entrance age for a child to attend kindergarten in the District is five (5) years of age on or before September 15 of the school year. The entrance age for a child to attend first grade is six (6) years of age on or before September 15 of the school year.

Before the student may enroll in the district's education program, the board will require evidence of age and residency in the form of a birth certificate or other evidence of age. It is within the discretion of the superintendent to determine what is satisfactory evidence for proof of age.

Prior to enrollment, the child must provide the administration with their health and immunization certificate. Failure to provide the information within the time period set by the superintendent is reason for suspension, expulsion or denying admission to the student.
