TEACHING METHODS

The teaching methods implemented in each classroom shall be the most appropriate scientifically research-based instructional strategies. The teaching staff shall keep up-to-date on new and promising scientifically research-based instructional methods used in schools throughout the nation and shall implement those which have the potential for improving student performance.

The strategies and methods teachers use shall focus on personalizing the learning process, including (1) appraising learning style(s), abilities, disabilities; (2) assessing individual learning needs; (3) developing, implementing, and evaluating quality learning experiences; and (4) modifying, when necessary, the instruction used.
