SPECIAL INTEREST LEARNING MATERIALS

Special interest learning materials are those that organizations, businesses, or special groups wish to provide for student/classroom use. The District's education program shall be mainly supported by District-approved materials and resources. When proposed for use in the District, special interest learning materials shall be evaluated on the appropriateness, quality, value, and consistency with the goals of the District's curriculum. Materials that contain advertising or are published by partisan or religious organizations may be used only if they do not violate law or Board policy. The Superintendent or his/her designee must approve, prior to their use, the use of special interest learning materials.
