ELEMENTARY SCHOOL CURRICULUM

The curriculum for students in kindergarten shall focus on the development of readiness skills in order to be successful with the basic learning expectations in future levels of instruction. The basic instructional program of students enrolled in kindergarten is designed to develop healthy emotional and social habits, language arts, and communication skills, the capacity to complete individual tasks, the ability to protect and increase physical well-being with attention given to experience relating to the development of life skills and human growth and development. The instructional approach will be non-sexist and multi-cultural.

The curriculum for elementary students (Grades K5) shall focus on the development of basic skills in English/language arts, social studies, mathematics, science, health, human growth and development, physical education, traffic safety, music, and visual art. The instructional approach will be non-sexist and multi-cultural.
