GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Students must successfully complete the courses required by the board and lowa Department of Education in order to graduate.

It is the responsibility of the Superintendent to ensure that students complete grades one through twelve and that high school students complete 48 credits prior to graduation.

The following credits will be required for graduation:

English - 8 credits

English 9 - 2 credits
English 10 - 2 credits
Speech - 1 credit
Literature - 1 credit
Composition - 1 credit

Elective - 1 credit

Social Studies - 6 credits

World Studies - 2 credits
American History or equivalent - 2 credits

Behavioral Social Science Elective - 1 credit

American Government - 1 credit

Science - 6 credits

Biology or equivalent - 2 credits Chemistry or equivalent - 2 credits Physics or equivalent - 2 credits

Math - 6 credits

Algebra 1 or equivalent - 2 credits Geometry or equivalent - 2 credits

Math Electives - 2 credits

PE - 4 credits Health - 1 credit

Financial Literacy / Personal Finance - 1 credit

Electives - 16 credits

The required courses of study will be reviewed by the board annually.

Prior to graduation, the district will advise students on how to successfully complete the free application for federal student aid.

Graduation requirements for special education students include successful completion of four years of English, three years of math, three years of social studies and three years of science.

Students who complete a regular session in the Legislative Page Program of the general assembly at the state capitol will be credited ½ credit of social studies.

Students enrolled in a junior officers' training corp will receive 1/8th physical education credit for each semester the student is enrolled in the program.
