POLICY: 800.5

BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS PROTECTION

Protection of the District's investment in its buildings and grounds is imperative. The District will make every

effort to adequately protect these investments.

Security means not only maintenance of a secure, locked facility but also protection from fire hazards, faulty

equipment, and unsafe practices in the use of electrical, plumbing, and heating equipment. The District encourages

close cooperation with local police, fire, and sheriff's departments and with insurance company inspectors. Protective

devices that are designed to be used as safeguards against illegal entry and vandalism may be installed where

appropriate. Employment of security personnel may be approved where special risks are involved.

Records and funds regarding protection of the buildings and grounds shall be kept in a safe place and under

lock and key where required.
