

RETIREMENT OF FACILITIES

The District shall conduct studies including relevant factors prior to consideration of facility retirement. Factors to be addressed in such studies may include the following as well as other factors that the Board may deem relevant:

1. student enrollments,
2. geographic location of student population,
3. building and site age, capacity, condition and suitability for current and future needs, and
4. District budgetary considerations.

The Superintendent may periodically recommend to the Board that certain buildings require further analysis relating to potential closure or recommend the closing of certain buildings.
