GIFTS TO THE DISTRICT

Gifts to the District are appreciated. Gifts, in general, are of three types: 1. those awarded at the Senior High to aid graduates in furthering their education (generally, these are in the form of cash, or are endowments or bequests that are to be converted to cash, or are in the nature of interest bearing investments whereby the returns can be used to award scholarship grants); 2. other kinds of gifts, including but not limited to land, buildings, building alterations, landscaping, and whose purpose would directly or indirectly aid the objectives of the District; or 3. donations or reimbursements from organizations for specific programs or activities. All gifts shall be approved by the District Board of Education. The Superintendent shall develop administrative guidelines governing the process for receiving gifts. The Superintendent shall have discretion, in rare and/or unusual situations to recommend the District accept a gift via merchandise or equipment if is in the best interest of the District to meet programming and/or academic needs. In these situations, the merchandise or equipment becomes the sole property of the District. Unless specified otherwise, gifts other than cash will be converted to cash upon receipt. All gifts shall be submitted to the Office of the Superintendent so proper approval and recognition can occur as appropriate.
