

FORT DODGE NOON KIWANIS SCHOLARSHIP

Guidelines and Application

Due March 16th

The Fort Dodge Noon Kiwanis Scholarship is administered by the Scholarship Committee and Board of Directors at the Fort Dodge Noon Kiwanis of Fort Dodge, IA. Three scholarships are given annually to graduating seniors, two from Ft. Dodge Senior High and one from St Edmond High School. This one-year scholarship is in the amount of \$500 total (\$250 per semester) and issued upon high school graduation to the college, university or business school of the student's choice. Children of Kiwanis Club members shall have first preference in consideration.

Basic Eligibility requirements:

Applicants for the scholarship shall be students who plan to attend a junior college, a four-year college or university or business school. The criteria which the donors shall base their decision on shall be, but not necessarily limited to, the following requirements:

- A. The recipient shall have a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.0.
- B. The receipt shall have outstanding personality and character traits, and operate under a high personal standard of moral conduct.
- C. Consideration will be given to the amount of community service activities the student has done.
- D. Financial need will be considered if necessary to make a decision on candidates who have almost identical qualifications.

Application Procedure:

Application for the scholarships shall be made on the attached "Fort Dodge Noon Kiwanis Scholarship Application" form. It shall be submitted to the Scholarship Committees of the respective schools. The Scholarship Committees will forward the applications to the Scholarship Committee Chairman of the Fort Dodge Noon Kiwanis for the final selection of the scholarship recipients.
