

FUTURE SCIENCE TEACHER SCHOLARSHIP

This \$1000 scholarship is for a student graduating from Fort Dodge Senior High School who is planning to become a middle school or high school science teacher.

Criteria:

They must have completed 8 credits of science by the time they graduate.

They must rank in the top $\frac{1}{3}$ of their class.

They must have strong character and have been active in activities in their school, church, and/or community.

They must enroll in a science education program at either a 2 year or a 4 year college/university.

They must fill out an application prior to May 1st in the spring they graduate.

A committee will review the applicants and select the recipient.

The award will be sent to the registrar's office in the fall after the recipient has started college.

The donor of the scholarship wishes to remain anonymous.
